The students can select either:

- All ATAR subjects
- A combination of General and ATAR subjects, with the possible inclusion of a VET course
- All General subjects, with the possible inclusion of a VET course

This decision will be based on a number of things including the student's interests, skills and goals.

There is a myth that undergraduate university admissions are made on the basis of ATAR only, however this is simply not correct. There are a number of ways for students to gain admission to a tertiary institution and we have a flexible system that assists students.

UNIVERSITY ENTRANCE

ATAR

A student choosing this pathway is aiming to gain direct entry to university.

A minimum of four ATAR subjects is required to be completed to achieve an ATAR at the end of Year 12. A student may also be required to complete prerequisite subjects for specific university courses.



UNIVERSITY ENTRANCE

CERTIFICATE IV

A student choosing this pathway is aiming to gain direct entry to university. To achieve this a student would need to do ATAR English (achieving a scaled mark of 50% or above in the ATAR exam) and complete a Certificate IV. It would also be strongly advisable to be adequately prepared for university to do at least 1 other ATAR subject such as Maths Application. This would gain entry to a Degree with the requirement of a 70 ATAR.

For entry to university enabling courses the student should aim to achieve A/B grades in non ATAR subjects and complete a Certificate IV in Year 12.

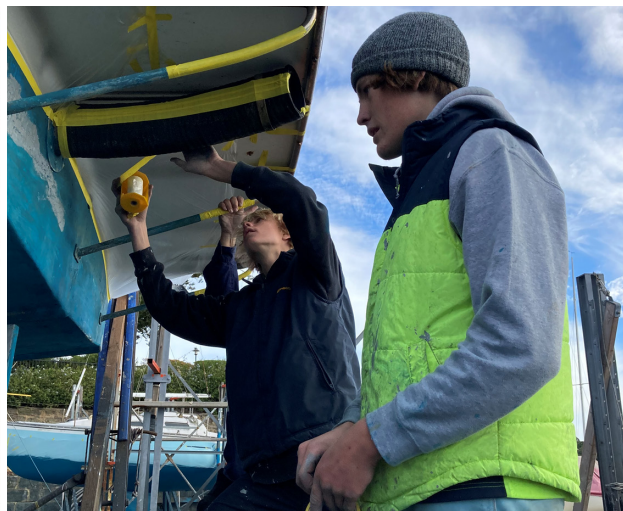
